<u>April 12-16</u> - Spelling tests given - teachers choose date & time to administer the tests to their classes, mark the tests and hand them back to the students

Individual prizes will be handed out to the students, based on the amount of money they raised. The prizes will be handed out once all the money is collected and tallied. Each child will receive a prize, the more money collected the larger the prize! The class in each grade that raises the most money overall will receive the honor of pieing a staff member in the face!
